PROJECT INFORMATION

AWAKENING is a community project shining a light on a key community issue. Below is a list of projects that need a lead artist, a group of artists, volunteers, builders, etc. While you are allowed to ideate your own project, this list of potential projects and locations needs your help. Project leaders will have an artist stipend of \$300+ depending on scope of work.

PROJECTS THAT NEED COLLABORATORS: PLEASE CIRCLE ONE

- Linear Sculpture** - (Cypress to Romney to Huger) Create an artwork to be experienced by bike or foot along a 0.6 mile section of the proposed Low Line.
- Bus Stops** - Artist-envisioned and fabricated - Patrons of the city buses need beautiful and functional places to experience as buses are en route.
- Bridgeview Babies Bike Lane** - Help the children of Bridgeview Village bike, walk, or scooter safely from their homes to Food Lion via Romney Street.
- Lowcountry Rapid Transit Hub & Community Space (LRTHCS)** - Envision and construct an engaging architectural piece for imagining a rapid transit center at the future site.
- Joseph Floyd Manor Projections** - Illuminating night shows on the Joseph Floyd Manor building from the lot between Meeting & King Street.
- Crosswalks** - Colorful infrastructure to promote safe pedestrian crossings utilizing a list of specific intersections from the City of Charleston & Charleston Moves
- Crosswalks: The Musical and/or Performances on Buses** - Activate crosswalks with short performances and/or perform on buses for Charleston Area Regional Transit Authority (CARTA) patrons en route.
- Wayfinding** - Dynamic signage to existing resources such as grocery stores, libraries, flood routes, etc.
