- General Emergency Assistance Program (GEAP) – rent assistance
- Please be advised that leaving your contact information will place you on the waitlist for an in-depth telephone screening ONLY. Please be advised that the wait list is limited to the first 25 calls or online submissions and someone from Palmetto CAP will contact you within the next 24-48 hours. **You can also apply for in-depth screening at any time (24/7) by using their automated phone system by dialing toll-free 1-844-769-6448 and choose option 1 and following the instructions.**

Available Laundry Services

At this time, Laundry Matters (located at 51 Reid St.) is open on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays from 9:00 AM-5:00 PM. Only three people are allowed in at a time, and are required to stay with their clothes and practice social distancing. College Laundry (located at 226 Calhoun St.) is also offering free drop-off and pick-up.
